Controlled Parking FAQ

Why did you put in a paid parking lot?

- We heard that many of our driver customers that wanted to stop at our facility could not, because our lot was full. We wanted to make sure that our driver customers have a place to park.

How much does parking cost?

- We certainly love our drivers and want to be sure there is ample parking available for driver customers so parking will be free for all driver customers.
- 24 hours of free parking if the driver purchases 75 gallons of fuel or \$50 worth of combined inside and shop purchases.
- Parking must take place immediately after fueling.
- The first two hours are free for everyone.
- If qualified purchases are not met, it is \$20 to park for every 24-hour period.
- 24 hours must be consecutive per ticket.

What do I have to do to validate my parking?

- Simply go to the diesel desk with your receipts (From the Travel Store, Blue Badger Bar & Grill, TA Truck Service, O&H, Dunkin', Taco Bell, Interstate Health) and they will validate your ticket. The receipts must be within the last 24 hours of validation. If you use TA's Reserve It parking, we will validate your parking.
- If you are here less than 2 hours, no validation is required.

Can I use the Parking Kiosk, so I do not have to wait in line at the diesel desk?

- Yes! Please use this when you are ready to leave and if you are NOT validating your parking. You will have one hour after you have paid for your parking at the kiosk to leave.

Do I need my ticket to exit the parking lot?

- Yes, you will most likely need your ticket to leave. If you have validated or paid at the kiosk before leaving, the gate may open automatically for you if it recognizes your license plate upon entry. If it does not recognize your license plate, you will have to put your ticket stub in at the exit gate.

Can I drop my trailer?

- Sure, all you need to do is go to <https://reserve-it.ta-petro.com> to reserve your spot to drop your trailer. Please come inside to the diesel desk to validate your parking.
